

## ZINE - NARRATIVE





Your task is complete a film review on the text **Shuffer Island**. You need to write a review pretending you are a famous film critic. The final presentation should be in the format of a 4 page ZINE. Your ZINE should contain media language discussing the Production and Story Elements used by the Director to engage the audience.

### Your Film Review Zine should comment on the following elements:

- 1. **Camera work** (framing, angle, focus, movement, POV)
- 2. **Sound** (*music, sound fx, voice over*)
- 3. Lighting (colour, brightness, shadow)
- 4. **Editing** (*cuts, fades, etc*)
- 5. Acting (how does the acting contribute to the scene?)
- 6. Visual composition & Mis-En-Scene (everything in shot)
- 7. Setting (location, season)
- 8. Time (order of events)
- 9. Multiple Storylines
- 10. Characters
- 11. Audience engagement

## My advice is to use the Narrative booklet to help with media language

## **ZINE – PRINT CODE & CONVENTIONS**

For this task you must follow the codes and conventions of the print media.

## To be completed:

- A four page coloured printed ZINE
- Page 1 Front Cover
- Page 2 Inside Front Cover
- Page 3 Inside Cover right hand side
- Page 4 Back Cover

## Must Haves:

- 1. Catchy title for your Zine
- 2. Headline for each article
- 3. All pictures must have captions
- 4. Colour tones must align with your target audience expectations
- 5. Font must align with you target audience expectations
- 6. All sections for the film text analysis completed
- 7. At least five strong images

### Things to consider before you start:

- 1. Do a plan
- 2. Search the internet to see what Zines exist and their layout
- 3. Research your film text and understand the language required for each section
- 4. Layout your ideas in your scrap book to ensure you have got layout right for your audience

<b>Clearness &amp; Functionality of the Zine</b> Content of the inside two pages are appropriate and aligns with the look and feel of the Cover. Audience expectations are satisfied
