

# STOP MOTION Premiere Pro

These instructions are to open, create and save and render a STOP MOTION short film in Premiere Pro.

Open Premiere Pro

## **New Project**

Name: \_\_\_\_\_

Browse (Select where you want to save it)

Desktop

Choose

Capture Format – HDV

OK

File

Import

Click on first image

Tick box Image Sequence

Import

Highlight project in the project box

File

New – Sequence from clip

(If you can't see the media on timeline – use the + to zoom it out)

Right click on project in the timeline

Speed / Duration

Duration (Drag the yellow numbers (bigger for slower) to your desired time)

Ok

### **Download song to MP3**

Go to [www.youtube-mp3.org](http://www.youtube-mp3.org)

Copy link of Youtube video and paste into the youtube-Mp3 website

Click covert video

Click download once processing is complete

In the box that appears at the bottom, click the arrow under save and chose Save As

Save the file into a network drive with the project

### **Import song**

Add song into A1 on the timeline

Drag red line to the end of your video

Control K (Cuts your song into two parts)

Delete the back of the song (That way song finishes at same time as footage)

Save

### **Render project so it plays as movie**

File

Export

Media

Format – H.264

Preset – Youtube HD 1080P 29.97

Tick box – Render at maximum depth

Tick box – Use Maximum Render Quality

Output name: Save As \_\_\_\_\_

Select destination to save

Save Export
