YOUR TASK

To complete a Short Film using the technique of Stop Motion. It is advised you use the computer software Premiere Pro to complete this task. However if you would like to use another program you are more familiar with then seek permission from your teacher. You can work by yourself or in pairs only. I am not concerned with length, therefore you can make your film as long as you like. However, remember that for each minute of footage you will need roughly100 photos.

WHAT YOU ARE GRADED ON

Set Design – Have you thought about the space and design of your Set? Make sure your images are clear and the colour tones are appropriate to your genre.

Video Clarity & Lighting – Are all shots clearly in focus? Think about your camera position and clarity of each shot. Consider how much lighting your set needs in order to create impact for your audience.

Video Framing & Composition – You final product shows evidence of composition and framing. Are your objects framed appropriately?

Audio – Think about the sound you wish to attach to your Stop Motion. Will it be a song, narration, sound effects? Consider the volume and sound levels before rendering your final short film.

Narrative – Have you planned out your story line? Are you going to have a plot, theme or climax to your narrative? Will you leave your audience in suspense? Will it be a linear or non-linear format?
