What is Street Art Photography?

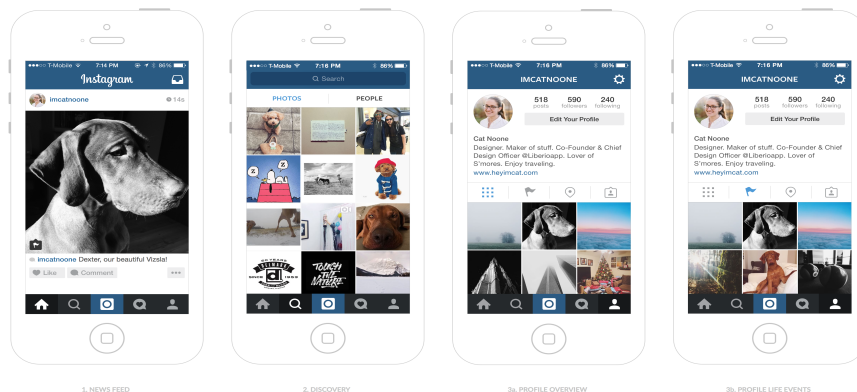
Street photography, also sometimes called candid photography, is photography conducted for art or enquiry that features unmediated chance encounters and random incidents within public places. Street photography can focus on people and their behaviour in public, thereby also recording people's history.

Your task:

Each student must create their own Instagram profile using Street Art Photography. The account will be a template only, not a live Instagram profile.

Your location can be anywhere you like.

Your Instagram must have minimum of 9 images. Print on an A3 or bigger page. Using an Instagram template for layout.



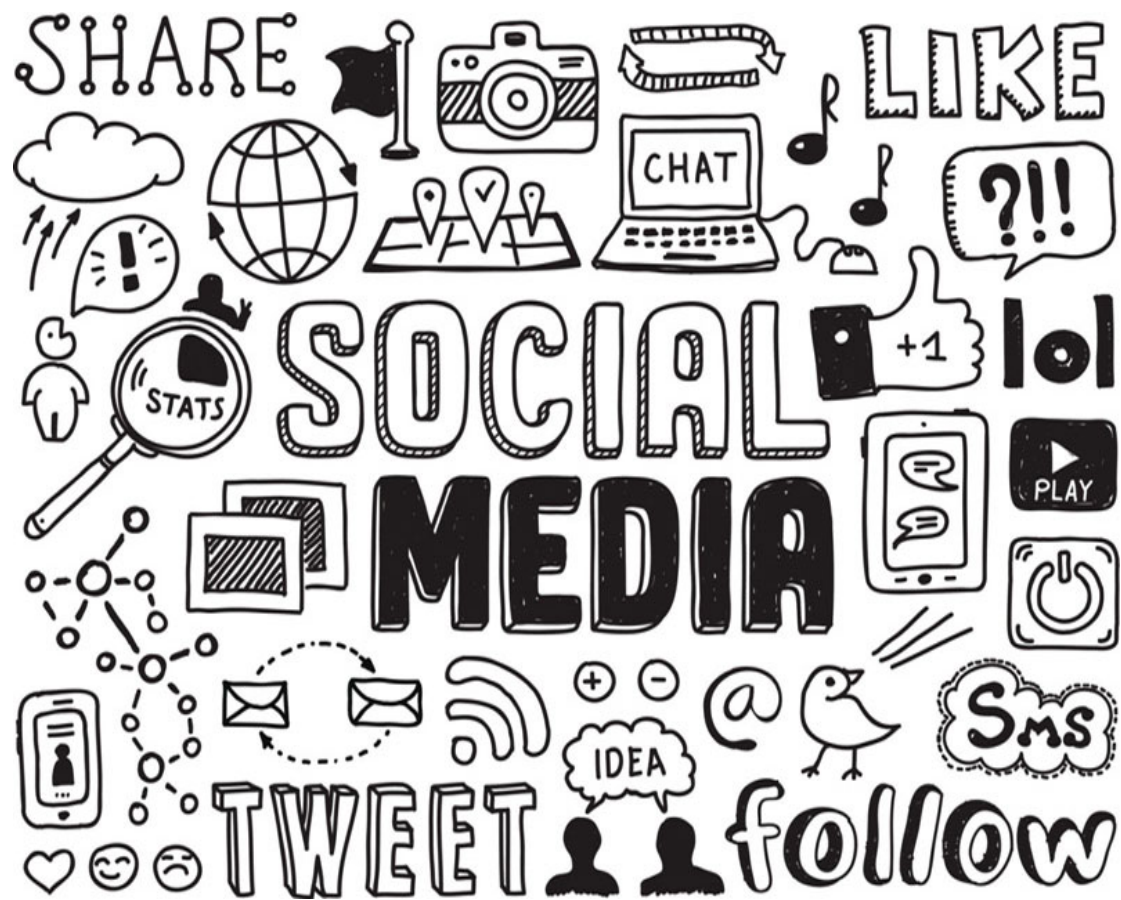
Your final selection of photographs must include:

- 3 images staged
- 3 images un-staged
- 3 images of your choice
- A hash-tag # to make a difference

Each image must have a narrative. The narrative can be:

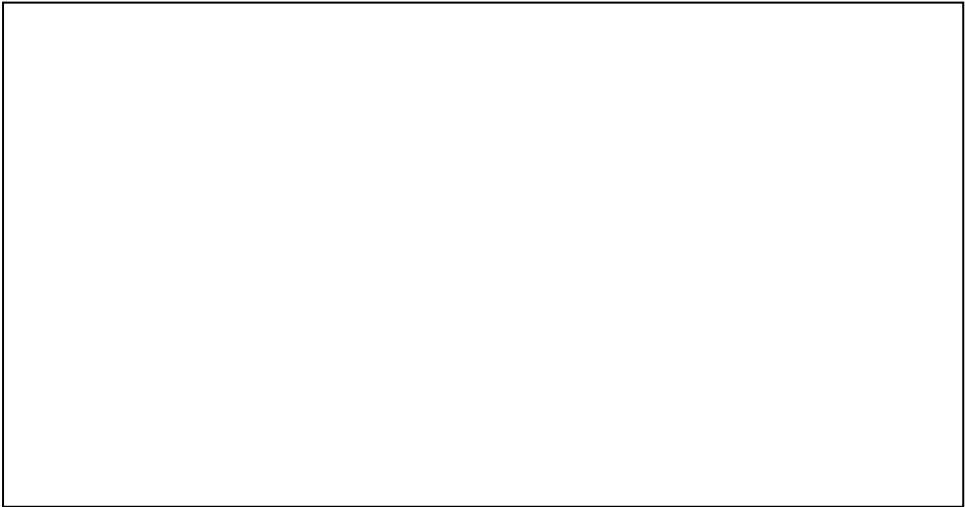
- Implied

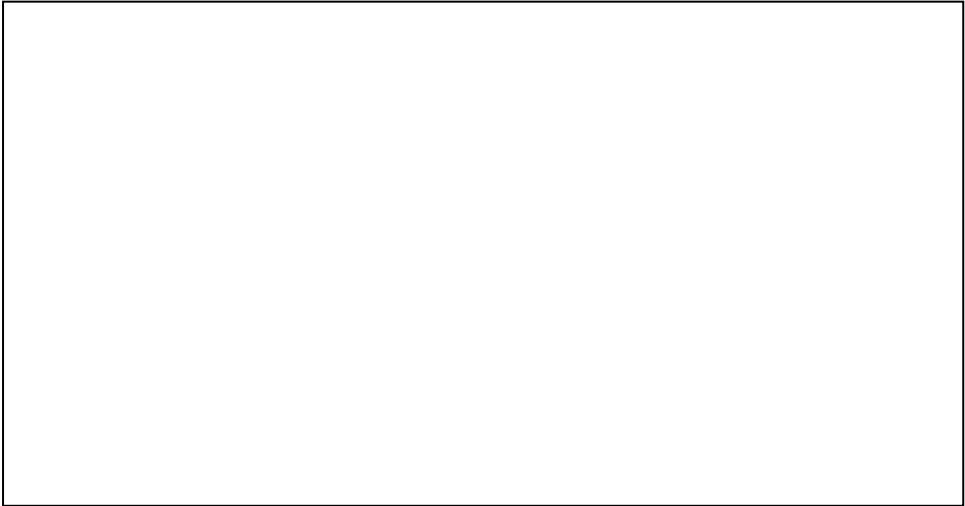

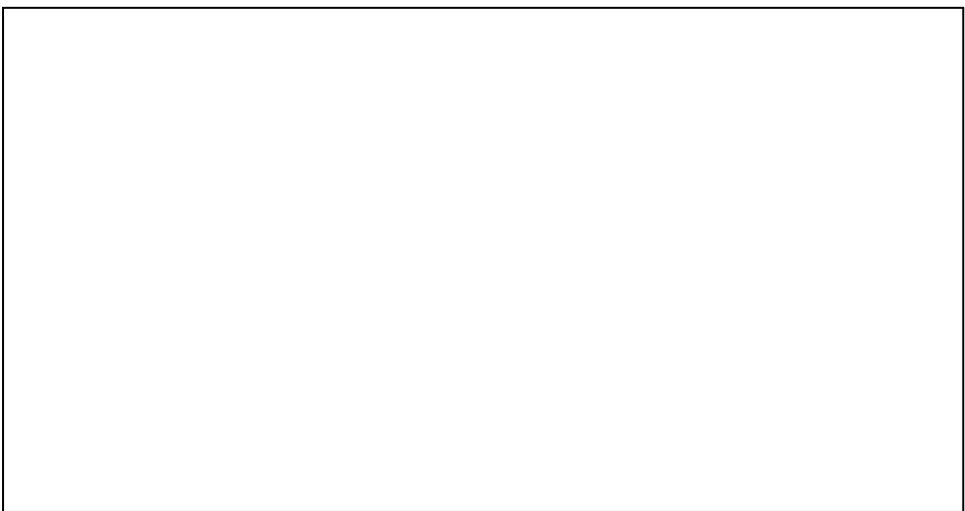
